



Simple Present

Present Progressive

Aussage

You like hamburgers.
Peter likes hamburgers.

I'm playing tennis. (I am playing...)
You're playing tennis. (You are playing...)
Peter's playing tennis. (Peter is playing...)

Verneinung

You don't like hamburgers.
Peter doesn't like hamburgers.

I'm not playing tennis. (I am not playing...)
You aren't playing tennis. (You are not playing...)
Peter isn't playing tennis. (Peter is not playing...)

Frage

Do you like hamburgers?
Does Peter like hamburgers?

Am I playing tennis?
Is Peter playing tennis?
Are you playing tennis?



Simple Present

vs.

Present Progressive

Handlungen die regelmäßig stattfinden!

Handlungen die jetzt in diesem Moment geschehen!

SIMPLE PRESENT

REGELMÄßIG

Peter plays tennis every Sunday.

PRESENT PROGRESSIVE

JETZT

Peter is playing tennis at the moment.



Signalwörter

Simple Present

VS.

Present Progressive

on Mondays = jeden Montag / montags
every Saturday = jeden Samstag / samstags
always = immer
usually = gewöhnlich
often = oft
sometimes = manchmal
never = niemals

look = Schau mal 
listen = Hör mal 
now = jetzt
right now = gerade jetzt
just = gerade eben
at the moment = im Moment
